WAB Integrated Voter Engagement (IVE) Team: Actions will include utilization of Beloved Community “scorecards” to evaluate candidates and educate voters, engaging presence at town halls of candidates, efforts to register voters, and strategies to ensure strong voter turnout. Trainings of IVE teams will be available online and free through WISDOM’s School of Democracy.

WAB Educational Team: will offer trainings on “christian” nationalism, white supremacy, protection of democracy, and building the Beloved Community. They will also conduct several large public events with nationally known speakers (e.g., Jim Wallis) and possibly a film series at a theater.

WAB Direct Action Team will implement public actions including several celebratory events, festivals, and rallies that exemplify and promote the Beloved Community and reject “christian” nationalism. They may also address proposed legislation promoting “christian” nationalism and white supremacy and which are a real threat to the Beloved Community.

WAB Media Team will manage a website with photos, videos, promotion of upcoming events, and educational information on democracy, “christian” nationalism, and the Beloved Community; will shape a digital strategy to promote the Campaign (e.g., Facebook, Instagram, etc.); develop Campaign literature, letters to the Editor, opinion pieces, media interviews; and produce Campaign billboards, bumper stickers and yard signs.
